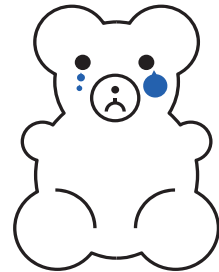
Brighter Beginnings Appeal?

- Beth Amison, mum of Maison, who suffocated when he got hold of a nappy sack.



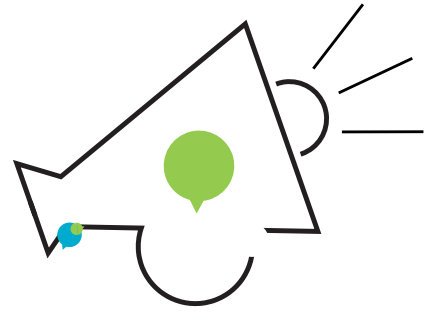
Harry's story

Keeping kids safe...

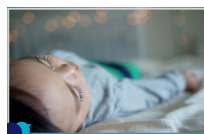

By getting down to our kids' level and seeing the world through their eyes, we can spot dangers, and help to keep them safe.

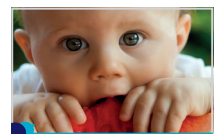

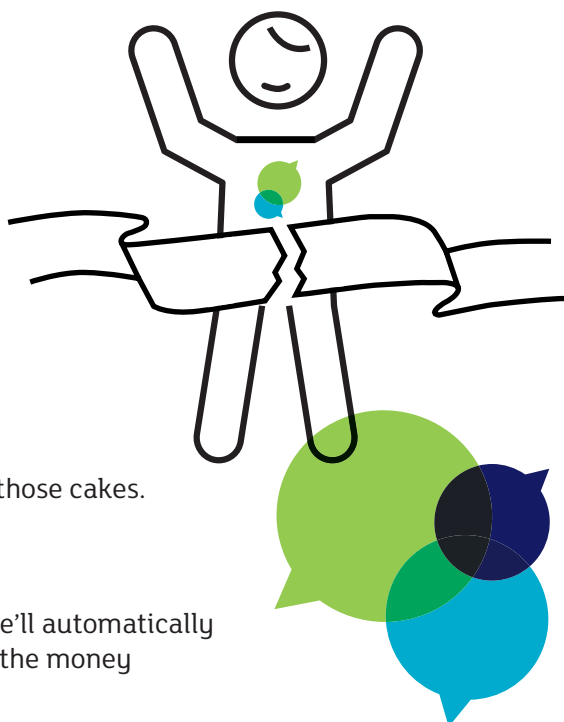

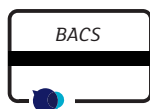
